For the first time in more than 20 years, the Baltimore Summer Antiques Show will add another day to its regular three-day run due to growth and interest.

Now in its 26th year, the antiques show boasts more than 500 different vendors of fine art, jewelry, books, silver, porcelain, furniture and many others. International and national decorators, shoppers, collectors and dealers make the show one of the largest and most important shows for the antique trade industry.

The show is expected to draw at least 25,000 visitors, said Palm Beach

Show Group co-managing partner Kris Charamonde. The Palm Beach Show Group acquired the show from founder Frank Farbenbloom in October of last year. "It really is a great event," Charamonde said. "When the opportunity came up for us to acquire it, we jumped on it."

"We have a lot of great dealers here who are very passionate about what they do. You don't get the general antiques dealer, instead you get specialists. These are some of the most knowledgeable and friendly people who will give you a full education," Charamonde said. "It's great place to come for everyone, a world-class event for people in antiques, right on Baltimore's doorstep."

Drusilla Jones, owner of Drusilla's Books, 17 N. Howard St. in Mount Vernon, has been participating in the show for the past 15 years. Specializing in children's and illustrat-

ed books as well as leather bindings, sets, art and architecture, Jones will be selling a variety of books, including a first edition "Oliver Twist" — priced at \$8,000 — and "Mother Goose" by Maud Humphrey, actor Humphrey Bogart's mother.

"People have all sorts of specialties," Jones said. One of her customers likes to collect children's books pertaining to WWI and WWII. "We all cater to our customers and try to find things they are looking for. People get that special wonderful feeling when they see the original. They feel something fabulous."

"We have everything that mankind has treasured over the last couple thousands of years. We have ancient Greek and Roman artifacts, 17th and 18th century French furniture. The depth and diversity is unparalleled," Charamonde said. "It's a very special event in the industry."
